

Mr. Mullis' Letter

February 26, 2025

This past weekend we had a major announcement concerning our capital campaign, Building Our Future. Below you will find that announcement. Please take some time to read the announcement and decide if you can help us take advantage of this very generous offer. Now is the time to act if you have not already done so.

Capital Campaign Announcement

The Capital Campaign Committee is pleased to announce that since Thanksgiving the Campaign has received new pledges of over **\$1.3 million**. This now puts the Campaign at **\$3.571 million**, which is 47%+ of our goal. Additionally, parish participation is just under 35%. This is all GREAT news to report.

But there is more good news to report. We also have a challenge to inform you about. A very generous donor has made the following challenge grant:

For every new pledge made and collected after 12.31.24 and by 12.31.26, they will match \$1 for \$1 up to \$500,000. If we can obtain \$500,000 in new pledges and collect those pledges, the Campaign could grow by \$1.0 million, \$500,000 in new pledges and \$500,000 by way of the matching grant.

First, if you have delayed making your pledge, this is an opportunity to make a pledge now and have it count double. If you pledge \$100 it will be worth \$200 to the Campaign. A \$2,500 pledge would be worth \$5,000. Please consider this opportunity and if you have any questions, reach out to Nora Boswell for additional information, nora.boswell@holynosarymemphis.org.

Second, if you have already fulfilled your pledge, you too can take advantage of this matching proposal. If you feel that you can afford to make an additional or add-on pledge, this new pledge can qualify for the matching grant.

This generous challenge grant is something we need to take advantage of. Please help us double the effectiveness of new pledges and get us closer to reaching our goal.






