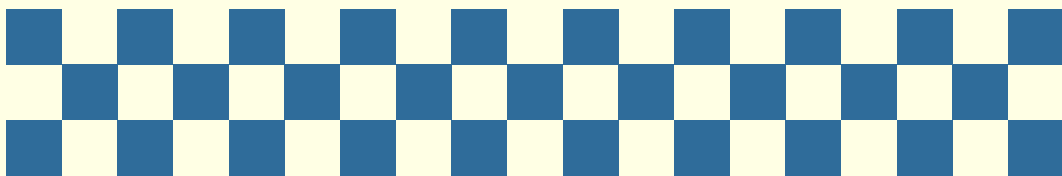
We take **anything & everything** -

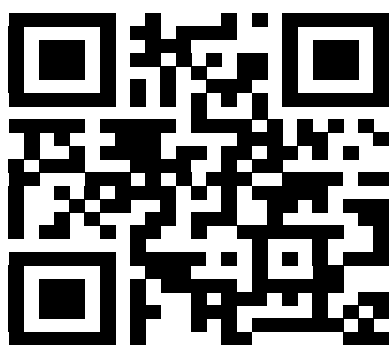
