We encourage all families to meet with their teacher to discuss how your child is doing academically, emotionally, and socially. All of these areas are important to your child's overall success in school. As always, if you have any immediate questions about your child's grades, you may contact their teacher for clarification.



#### Pick-up:

- When you arrive to pick up your child each day we ask that you call the Aftercare number and let the staff know you are here. They will instruct you as to where they will meet you with your child.
- The Aftercare number is 901-724-5781. Please put this number in your phone.
- If you get to school and do not have the number it is posted on the main door and the red awning door for your convenience.
- Parents are responsible to clock their child out each day. The Aftercare staff will have an iPad for you to clock out with.
- You will need your personal FACTS ID number to clock out. If you do not know your ID number you can find it in your Family Portal account on the Family page. Also, the Aftercare staff can help you with your number if needed.
- Any child that is not clocked out will be given a clock out time of 6:00pm. Please be sure to clock your child out before you leave.
- If someone other than you will be picking up your child please notify the school beforehand. You may email your teacher or Ms. Bryan, call the school office, or call Ms. Bryan on the aftercare phone once Aftercare has started. Let them know the name of the person who is picking up and be sure to give that person your ID number to clock out your child(ren).

#### New Altar Server Training October 26th



October 17 Students will visit the fair and make their wish list.


- <u>October 18</u> The book fair is open for business today! Students may shop during their library time or any time their teacher sends them. All items are taxed.

One in five children in the U.S. have learning and attention issues such as dyslexia and ADHD

#### **Facts About Dyslexia**

- Dyslexia is a language-based learning disability that is neurological in origin
- Dyslexia is the most common learning disability. It affects 15-20% of the population.
- People with dyslexia are often more creative and out of the box thinkers.
- Having dyslexia is not linked to intelligence. People with dyslexia typically have average to above average intelligence.
- 40% of entrepreneurs are dyslexic.
- Dyslexic see in pictures and not in black and white.
- 1 out of 6 words is phonetically irregular.
- Dyslexia is highly hereditary. If a parent has dyslexia there is a 50% chance the child will also. It can range from mild to severe.
- Dyslexic are out of the box thinkers.
- It is characterized by deficits in word recognition and/or decoding, spelling, and phonological awareness. Other characteristics may include poor reading comprehension, poor written expression, and/or difficulty organizing information for study and recall.


